Los Primeros School of Sciences & Arts Registration Information

Los Primeros School of Sciences & Arts (LPSSA) is a K-8 Magnet School located at 1555 Kendall Avenue in Camarillo. Student registration for LPSSA is handled by a lottery. Parents interested in having their student(s) attend LPSSA for the 2017-18 school year **must submit a lottery application to LPSSA or the District Office February 1 - February 17, 2017.**

Siblings of LPSSA students not currently attending LPSSA must apply through the lottery. Students on the 2016-17 waiting lists must reapply for 2017-18 school year. Students currently attending LPSSA do not need to re-enter the lottery. They will automatically be enrolled at LPSSA for the next school year.

Parents will be contacted with the lottery results starting February 22, 2017. Kindergarten and new students selected for LPSSA will register directly at LPSSA during the week of February 27 – March 3, 2017. **Kindergarten or new students to Pleasant Valley School District not selected in the lottery should then register at their neighborhood school during the week of February 27 – March 3, 2017.**

GUIDELINES:

The following are attendance priorities established by the school board. They will act as guidelines in determining placement of students with regard to the choice policy for Los Primeros School of Sciences & Arts.

- ◆ Siblings of current LPSSA students living in or in escrow for property in the 2007/2008 Los Primeros neighborhood by July 1, 2008
- ◆ Neighborhood students living in or in escrow for property in the 2007/2008 Los Primeros neighborhood by July 1, 2008
- ◆ Students of PVSD Intra/Inter-District Non-Exempt Employees
- ◆ Siblings of current LPSSA students
- ◆ Children residing within Pleasant Valley School District boundary
- ◆ Children residing outside Pleasant Valley School District boundary

When requests exceed the available space, selections will be made from the request pool by lottery. Students placed in any school requested through the intra-district school choice (lottery) process shall, for enrollment purposes, be considered residents of that school and shall no longer have first priority rights to enroll in the school of the attendance area in which they reside. Students who wish to subsequently transfer to another school of their choice may apply for such enrollment through intra-district school choice.
