PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

PVSD preschool program is designed for children who are 4 years old and will be entering a kindergarten program the following year. The program offers an opportunity to learn by being actively involved with developmentally appropriate materials in the areas of language, cognitive, social, emotional, creative and physical development.

Attendance in a quality preschool program enhances school readiness and we find that both parents and children have an increased comfort level entering Kindergarten when they have already spent time on a school campus.

The PVSD preschool program exceeds the requirements as set forth by California Community Care Licensing. We adhere to a 1:8 student/teacher ratio and all classes are taught by highly qualified teachers who have specialized in early childhood education and hold a California State Preschool Permit.

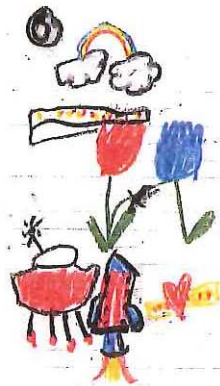

CURRICULUM:

The preschool curriculum is based on *Creative Curriculum*, a state approved curriculum, which supports California Preschool Learning Foundations. This curriculum is also aligned with California Content Standards and Common Core State Standards. All children will be assessed regularly using the California Desired Results Developmental Profile. Staff will share results with parents during parent conferences or upon request.

The day to day classroom experience provides a comprehensive program that includes, not only academics, such as math concepts, literacy and writing, but also provides children the opportunity to engage in enriching activities such as music and movement, gardening, and art expression.



PROGRAM HOURS:

PVSD offers both morning and afternoon class schedules (pending enrollment). Session times are:

8:15am-11:15am or 12:00pm-3:00pm

Classes are held Monday-Friday.

TUITION and SCHOLARSHIPS:

Tuition is charged monthly, Sept-May (9 months) and is a level payment plan. Tuition is the same every month, regardless of the number of days. Tuition amount is \$490.00/month.

Tuition assistance is available through California State Preschool Program (CSPP), PVNfL First Five Program, and the District. Financial assistance is based on need and will be determined at the time of enrollment.

REGISTRATION:

Registration for the 2017-18 school year begins on April 3, 2017. Registration will be accepted until April 27, 2017.

Registration packets are available at the PVSD District Office and preschool locations.

All students must be 4 years old by Sept. 1, 2017 in order to register for the preschool program for 2017-18.
